In 1926, Pope Pius XI instituted Mission Sunday, celebrated on the next to the last Sunday in October, as the feast of catholicity and universal solidarity so *Christians* [i.e. not Catholics only] the world over will recognize their common responsibility with regard to the evangelization of the world. There is a special collection today, the majority of which goes to support the Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

Additionally, the *Ordo* notes that a Mass “For the Spread of the Gospel” (#14 For Various Needs and Occasions) may be used. For the readings, see *Lectionary, Volume IV*, nos. 872-876, especially Isa. 60:1-6, Rom. 10:9-18, Matt. 28:16-20.
