FACULTIES: HOLY WEEK

20. A. PRIESTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE CHRISM MASS MAY ALSO CELEBRATE ANOTHER MASS THAT SAME DAY FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE FAITHFUL.
- B. ON HOLY THURSDAY, BESIDES THE PRINCIPAL MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER, A PRIEST MAY CELEBRATE ONE OR TWO ADDITIONAL MASSES. AN EVENING MASS MAY BE ALLOWED FOR PASTORAL REASONS. A MORNING MASS MAY BE PERMITTED IF THERE IS GENUINE PASTORAL NECESSITY.
- C. A PRIEST MAY BINATE OR TRINATE ON HOLY THURSDAY IN ORDER TO PROVIDE MASSES FOR THE FAITHFUL.
- D. THE GOOD FRIDAY LITURGY MAY BE REPEATED IF THERE IS A PASTORAL NEED TO DO SO. HOLY COMMUNION MAY BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FAITHFUL ONLY AT THE CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S PASSION, BUT MAY BE BROUGHT AT ANY HOUR OF THE DAY TO THE SICK WHO CANNOT TAKE PART IN THE LITURGY. THE GOOD FRIDAY LITURGY MAY BEGIN AT NOON, BUT NO LATER THAN 9:00 P.M.
- E. MEMBERS OF THE LAITY MAY READ OR SING THE PASSION OF OUR LORD DURING HOLY WEEK.
- F. AFTER THE MASS OF THE VIGIL ON HOLY SATURDAY, ANOTHER MASS MAY BE SCHEDULED ANTICIPATING THE EASTER OBLIGATION ONLY IF THERE ARE SUFFICIENTLY GRAVE PASTORAL REASONS FOR DOING SO.
- G. PASTORS MAY ARRANGE THAT THE EASTER VIGIL LITURGY BE CELEBRATED EARLY EASTER SUNDAY MORNING IF IT IS NOT CELEBRATED ON HOLY SATURDAY EVENING BETWEEN SUNDOWN AND MIDNIGHT.
